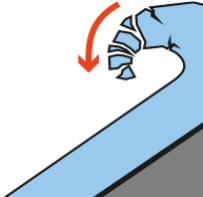

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will continue to form in sheltered locations. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North, North-East and East aspects above 900m. Avalanches are likely in these locations especially during the afternoon. Unstable cornices will form above these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable

Strong South-West winds with snow above 900m becoming heavy during Tuesday afternoon.

Comments

Strong winds expected on Tuesday with the conditions deteriorating into Wednesday. Any windblown snow surfaces above 900m will be frozen.
