

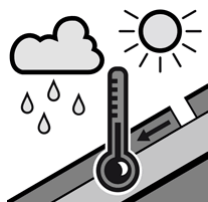

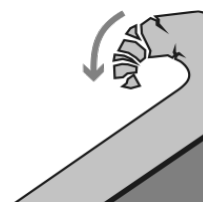

Wind Slab



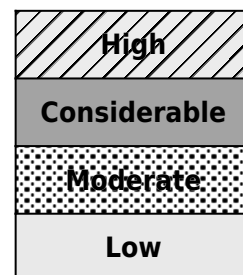
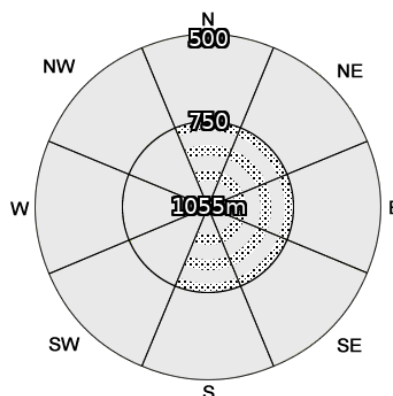

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some fresh accumulations of unstable windslab will build in very sheltered locations on North-East to South-East aspects. Greatest accumulations will be in gully exits and corrie rims. There will be cross loading on slopes on a northerly and southerly aspect. Cornices will also build on these aspects. These deposits should be easily identifiable from the surrounding older snow pack. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will gradually rise during the night and early morning to around the summits by midday. Winds will gradually strengthen from a Westerly direction accompanied by light snow showers.

Comments

Another blustery day hampered by frequent snow showers above 400m. Soft snow pack below 750m
