

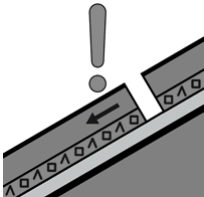

Wind Slab



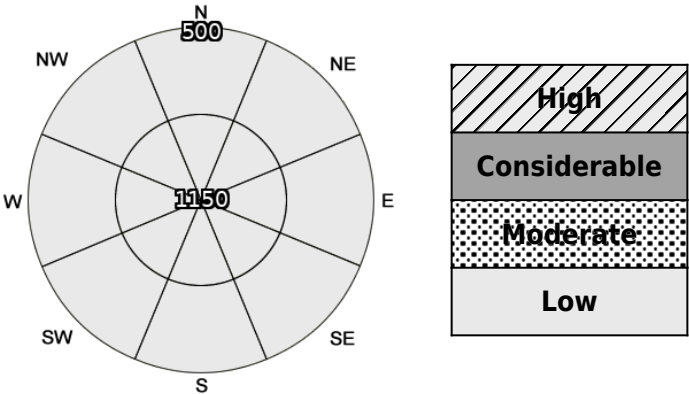
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will form on North to East aspects, mainly above 850 metres, and on North-West and South-East aspects due to cross loading. Cornices on these aspects will continue to build and become unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The strong Westerly wind will back South-Westerly. The freezing level will be initially around 200 metres rising gradually to 800 metres through the period. Light snow showers overnight will become more persistent snowfall by the afternoon.

Comments

Hazards developing after a settled period. In general, the deeper deposits of fresh snow seem better bonded but more fresh snow is expected.
