Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing areas of windslab will become increasingly unstable as the thaw becomes established. Wet snow avalanches are likely, mainly on steep North, North-East and East aspects above 900m. Instabilities will also be present in other locations. Cornices will become unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong South-West winds will continue. Precipitation will initially be snow but will quickly turn to rain at all levels during the night and continue through the day.
