
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a steady thaw of the snow pack at all levels, which will deplete further. Some surface sluffs may occur on the steepest slopes but generally stability will be good. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force south westerly winds accompanied by rain showers with the freezing level rising well above the summits.

Comments

Windier today with reduced visibility above 750m. Gale force winds forecast for next two days. Risk of falling ice or snow from buttresses and any river/burn crossings may prove hazardous.
