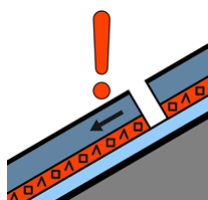
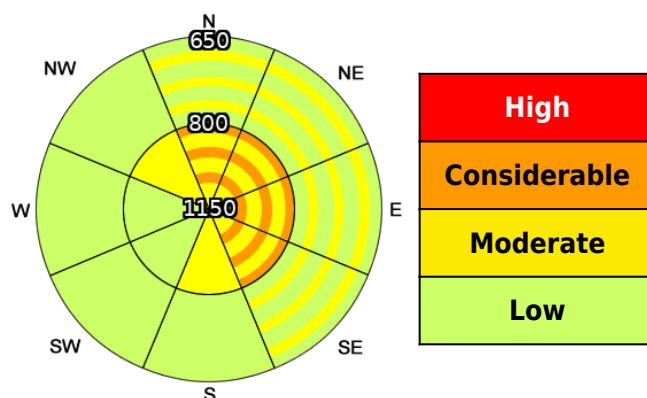


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 18/02/2015****Avalanche Problems****Persistent Weak Layers****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be some consolidation of the snowpack but areas of unstable windslab will be found on North to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Particularly affected will be gully exits, steep convex and scarp slopes. Older snow-ice on other aspects will soften but remain stable. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will rise to above the summits with very light rain throughout the period. Winds will be strong from the South-West.
