

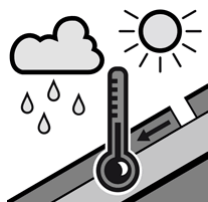

Avalanche Problems



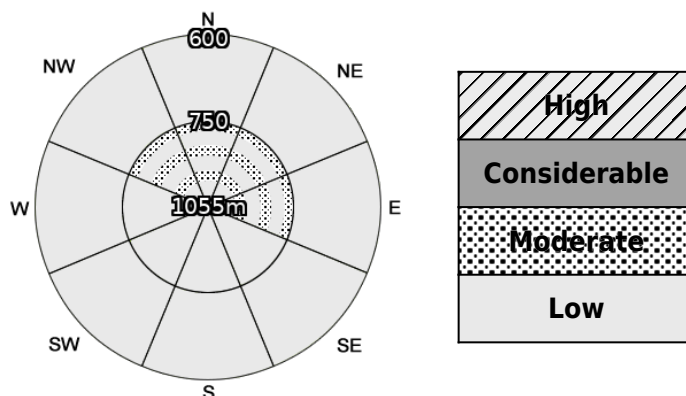
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The diminishing snowpack will gradually refreeze and be generally stable. Some localised accumulations of windslab will develop in very sheltered locations on North- West to East aspects above 750m. These accumulations are likely to be small in extent and avoidable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Fairly constant rain at all levels will gradually turn to snow showers during the night as the freezing level lowers to around 500m by early morning. Winds will gradually reduce in strength to around 40mph over summits by dawn and will remain South-Westerly in direction.
