

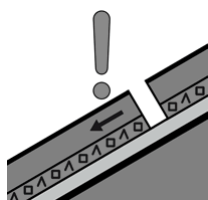

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 20/02/2015

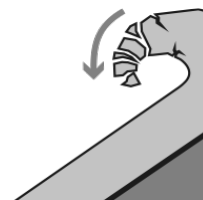
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab



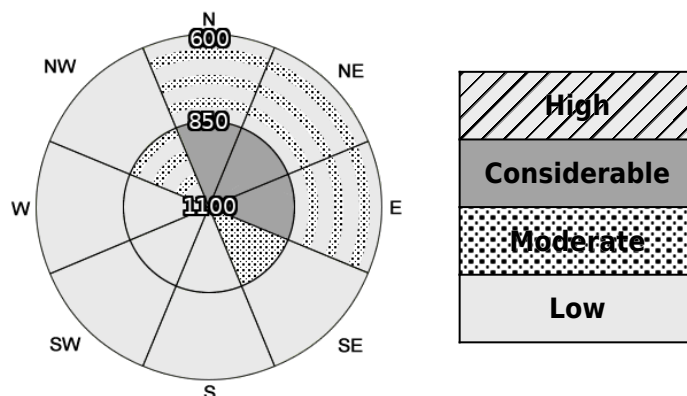
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Good stability on all slopes and ridge-lines directly exposed to the wind. Poor stability mainly on very steep North to East facing scarp slopes and gullies above 850m where avalanches are likely. Weak cornice development expected over steep lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers overnight and throughout the day carried on strong West-South-Westerly winds. Remaining cold. Freezing level around 500 metres.

Comments

Wintry today with snow falling to all levels by afternoon. Effective snow line 600m. Best snow-ice above 750m on Thursday, though wet snow below this altitude.
