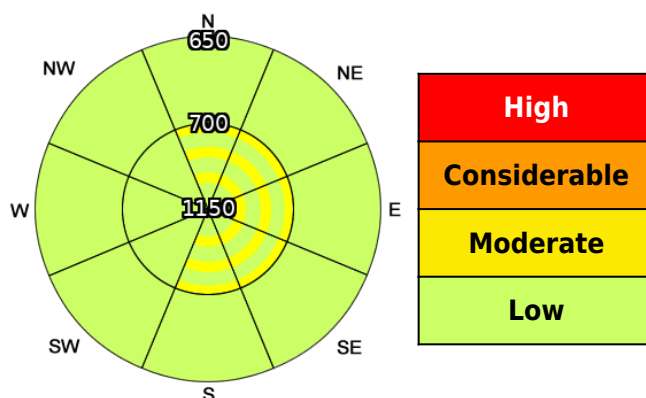
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderate to poorly bonded windslab will be present in sheltered locations on North through East to South aspects above 700 metres. Deeper accumulations will be found in gully exits and around corrie rims. The majority of the remaining snowpack will be firm and well bonded. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Cloudy but dry until mid-afternoon when there will be some very light snow showers. Cold, with a 250 metre freezing level and fresh to strong West-North-Westerly veering North-North-Westerly winds.
