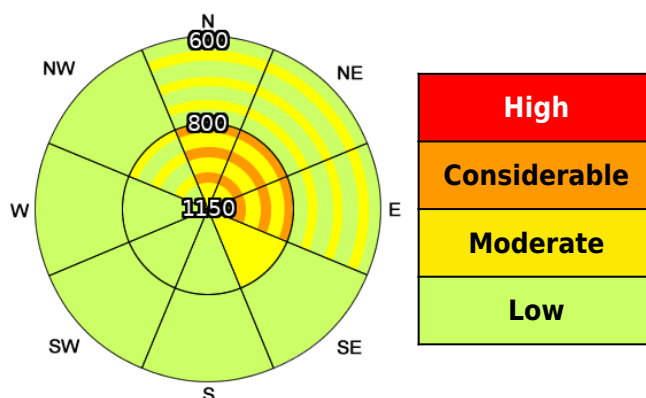
Wind Slab

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The older snow will be firm and stable. Localised unstable accumulations will develop on North to East aspects above 800 metres. Other aspects, mainly South-Easterly will also be affected by cross-loading. Greatest hazard will be found in gully exits and on steep sheltered scarp slopes. Exposed locations will be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

There will be snow showers throughout the period with the freezing level lifting to around 600 metres by the end of the day. Gale force winds will be mostly from the South-West.

##### Comments

Snowpack surface is firm and becoming icy where exposed to the wind.
