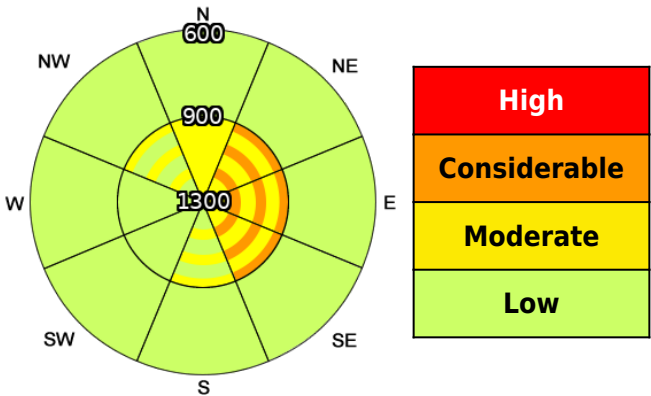

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will diminish in extent as it warms. Some consolidation will take place in the snowpack, however some instabilities will remain, but will be confined to mostly steep and convex shaped terrain on mainly North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 900 metres where the deepest accumulations remain. Many areas will be scoured and bare especially West facing and wind exposed locations. Cornices on Easterly aspects will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be storm force South-Westerly. Freezing level around summits. Some precipitation from midday falling as snow above 1000 metres.
