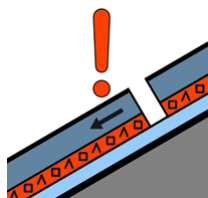
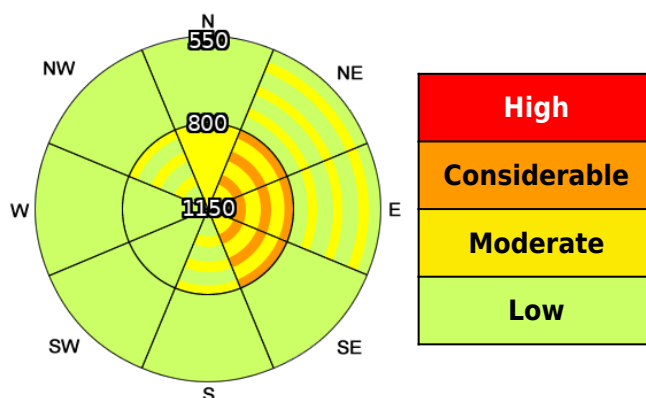


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE CONSIDERABLE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 05/03/2015****Avalanche Problems****Persistent Weak Layers****Wet Snow****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Stability will become increasingly poor throughout the day with unstable accumulations found on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres, especially in the deeper more extensive poor to weakly bonded accumulations. Cornices on Easterly aspects will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The freezing level will rise above the summits with some very light rain later in the day. Gale force winds will increase during the day and mainly be from the South-West.

Comments

Cornice collapse likely to be a trigger in thaw conditions. Good route selection will be essential for those out on the hill on Thursday.
