#### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 05/03/2015


##### Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab




Wet Snow

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poor stability on all lee slopes. Most affected areas will be on North-East to South-East aspects above 750m where avalanches will occur. Recently formed formed cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High



##### Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will rise during the night to well above the summits by dawn accompanied by light snow showers turning to rain later. Winds will strengthen to gale force South-Westerly by mid-morning.

##### Comments

Lots of fresh unconsolidated snow above 400m. Skis or snowshoes recommended. The snow below this level is moist and starting to melt. Windward slopes and ridges are sheathed in very hard snow-ice above 700m.
