Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will be saturated with wet snow instabilities affecting sheltered gullies and steep North through East to South-Easterly aspects mainly above 800 metres where avalanches will occur. Many of these areas are also affected by large cornices which will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be High



Forecast Weather Influences

Stormy conditions will continue with very strong South-Westerly winds on Friday. There will be persistent heavy rain with sleet possible at the highest levels. The freezing level will remain above the summits.
