

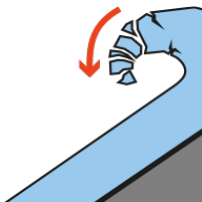

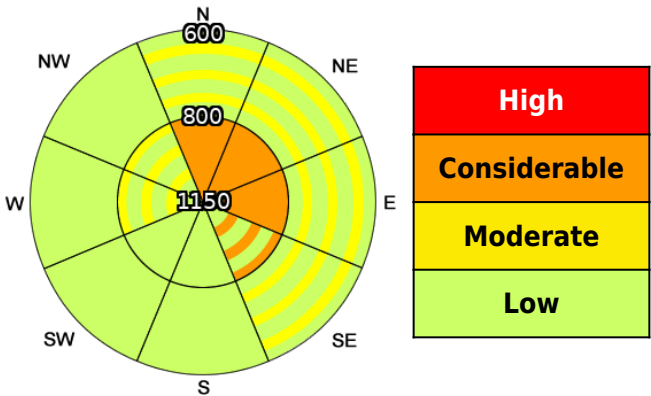

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will become further moistened and destabilised. In areas where there are deeper deposits of snow, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres avalanches are likely. These have the potential to be large and to run to lower altitudes. There may also be a possibility of full depth releases on steep ground. Remaining cornices will become weaker and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The wind will be severe gale force South-South-Westerly , easing slightly mid morning before increasing in strength once more later. There will be extremely heavy and persistent rain throughout the period at all levels which will only ease in the late afternoon.

Comments

Extremely mild wet weather forecast with high winds - further wet slab releases expected.
