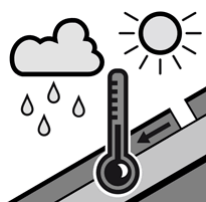


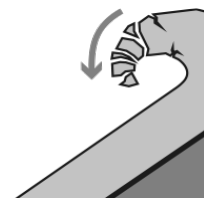

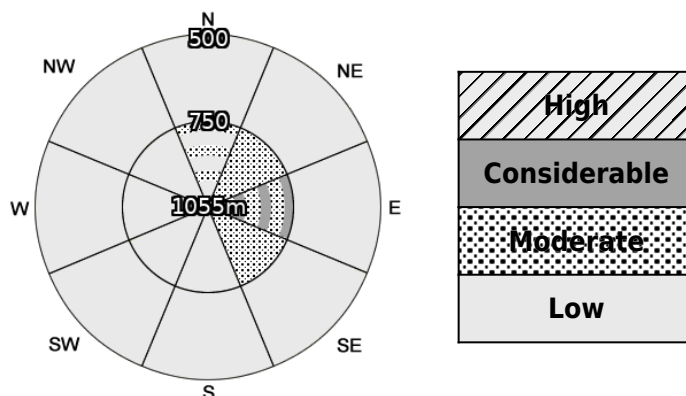

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw. Wet surface instabilities will be possible on steep terrain on mainly North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 750 metres, where accumulations are more significant on Easterly aspects, avalanches are likely. Below this level the snowpack will be moist to depth but generally stable. Cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Storm force South-South-Westerly winds will continue through the night, lessening to moderate strength during the morning before increasing to storm force once more during the afternoon. Persistent and heavy rain to summit levels with some sleet on the tops in the morning.

Comments

Storm force winds overnight and again during the day, with persistent rain, colder on Sunday
