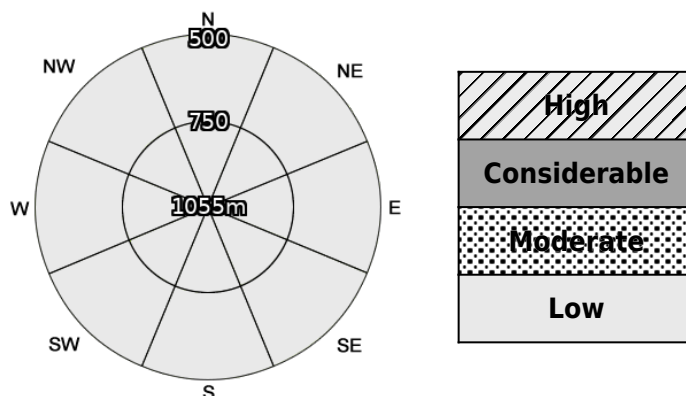
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack which is more extensive on North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 800 metres will consolidate, gradually refreeze and become stable throughout. Some new snow accumulations may form on North-East to Easterly aspects but are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Persistent rain with storm force South-Westerly winds will continue into the evening. Winds will lessen through the night veering Westerly then becoming lighter West- South-Westerly. Freezing level lowering to 500 metres. Light snow showers expected above 400 metres.
