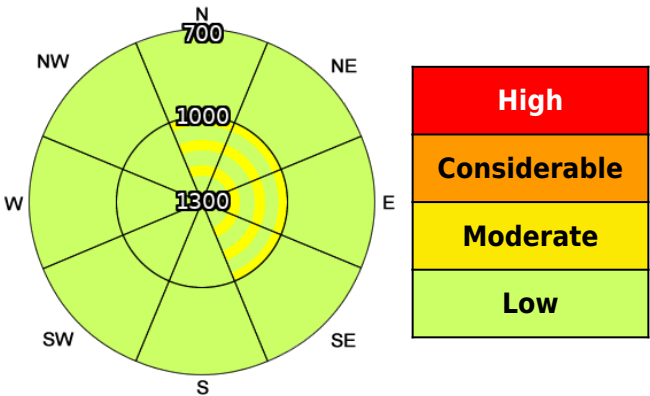
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The overall snowpack will become generally well bonded and stable in the cooler temperatures. Localised accumulations of windslab will develop around corrie rims and gully tops mainly above 1000 metres on North through East to South-East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Mild conditions continuing into the first part of the evening with light rain at all levels, this turning to snow over the summits. Freezing level lowering to 500 metres during the day with some light snowfall. Strong winds will be South-South-West to Westerly.

Comments

Freezing level beginning to fall overnight. Main gully lines complete, rock fall still a potential hazard.
