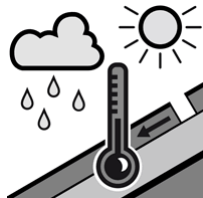

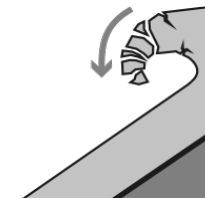

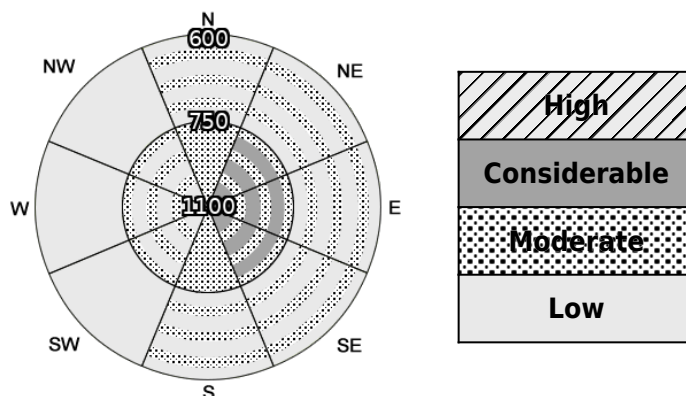

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Colder, drier conditions will help consolidate the snowpack on less steep ground above 600m. Deeper snow deposits on all steep North to South-East aspects above 750m will remain wet at depth and be only marginally stabilised. Lingering full depth avalanche potential on some selected North-East to South-East aspects. Remaining cornices will be weak. Some new moderately stabilised windslab is expected on North to East aspects above 800m later. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Very wet overnight then significantly colder with some snow showers. Winds easing and becoming Westerly or South Westerly.

All burns, rivers, paths, hill-tracks, roads and hillsides in full spate on Saturday.
