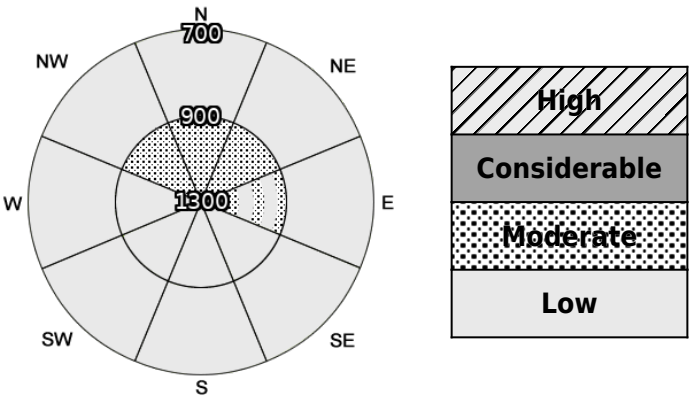
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New accumulations of windslab will develop on North-West to North-Easterly aspects mainly around corrie rims and gully tops above 900 metres. Cross loading will affect other aspects. Elsewhere will be generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Mainly dry overnight, snow showers through the day. Moderate South-West winds will back to the South-South-East and increase to gale force. The freezing level will rise to around 1000 metres during the day.

Comments

Unsettled wintry weather over the next few days with a fluctuating freezing level.
