### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 10/03/2015

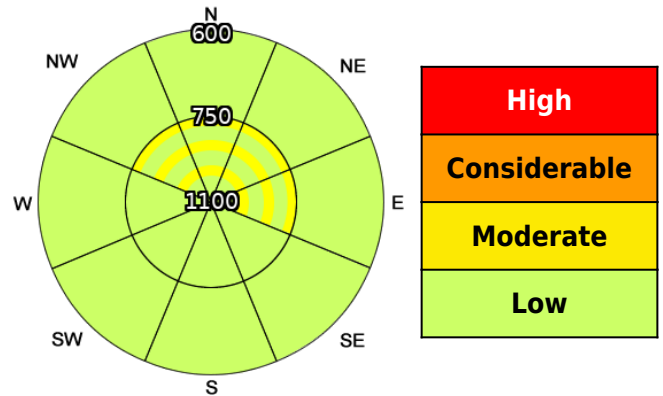
#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Stability will be good on all old re-frozen and wind scoured slopes. Some very localised accumulations will develop on North- West to Easterly aspects in very sheltered locations above 750m and be easily distinguishable from the older snowpack. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Gale force Southerly winds will moderate and veer Westerly accompanied by light snow showers. The freezing level will be around 500m by early morning and gradually rise to 700m by early evening.

#### Comments

Travel is now much easier as the snowpack has firmed up. There is little ice build up in Coire Ardair and climbing conditions remain poor.
