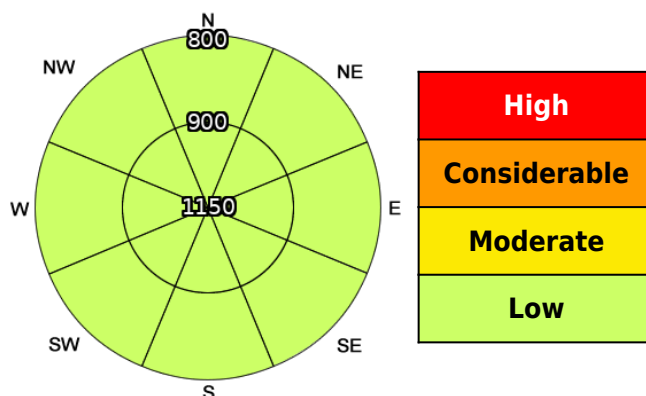


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 18/03/2015****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The patchy snowpack will soften but remain well bonded and stable on all aspects. Greatest amounts will be found on North-East and East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will be a mainly dry day but the freezing level will lift to around the higher summits with some sleet towards the end of the day. Winds will remain light and will back to the West during the afternoon.
