
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Small localised accumulations of new slab on steep East and South East aspects are possible at highest elevations above 900m late in the day. Elsewhere in the main the snowpack is well consolidated and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing levels will fluctuate around summits with some light showers initially of rain and sleet overnight, turning to snow later in the day. Winds will be fresh generally Westerly veering and strengthening North Westerly with the arrival of a cooler airflow.
