
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain soft, moist and generally stable throughout the period. A small amount of snow will be deposited on South to South-West aspects on the highest summits, but this will melt during the day. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

The strong North-West winds will ease overnight to a light Easterly by morning, increasing again by the end of the afternoon and veering South-West. Little precipitation is forecast with a flurry of snow at summit level early morning. The freezing level will be generally above the summits with a dip overnight to 900 metres.

Comments

There is a significant difference in snow accumulations at the moment between the western and eastern mountains of Torridon with most accumulation on the east end of Beinn Eighe.
