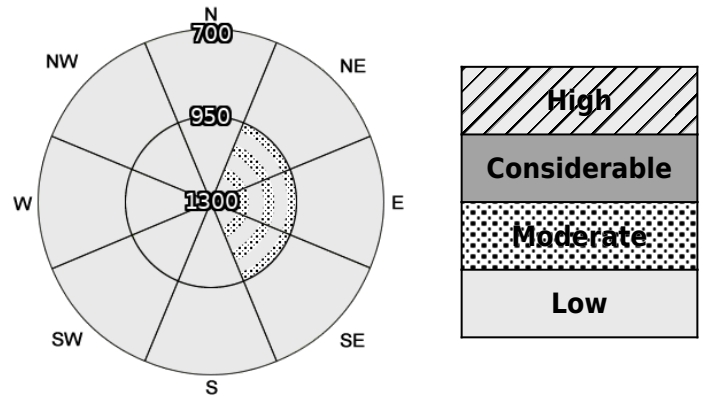
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

In general the old snowpack will remain well bonded and stable on all aspects and altitudes. Localised accumulations of windslab will develop mostly around corrie rims and gully tops on North-East to South-East aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Much cooler with snow showers expected above 700 metres. Moderate to strong winds will veer from the South-West and become more Westerly. The freezing level will lower to 800 metres.
