

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The old snowpack will re-freeze and be much firmer in all locations. New moderately stabilised soft windslab will accumulate mainly on steep North East to South East aspects above 800m. New soft cornices will begin to form above steeper lee slopes. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Becoming much colder with some snow showers. Winds will be moderate South-Westerly, later North-Westerly.

Comments

Much colder summit temperatures in prospect. Freezing level around 600m.
