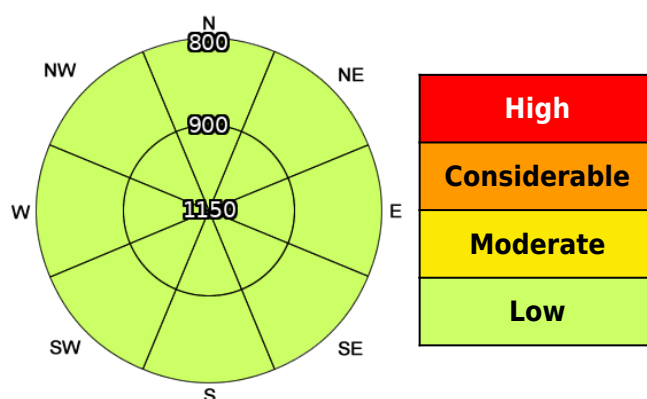


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 24/03/2015****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Any new snow will be insignificant. The older snow cover will re-freeze becoming firm, icy and stable throughout. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will become much cooler with the freezing level dropping to around 500 metres. A dry morning forecast with a dusting of new snow later in the afternoon. Winds will initially be from the West but veering and strengthening to moderate from the North-North-West.

Comments

Existing snow cover likely to become very firm and icy. New West moving weather system not forecast to reach Southern Cairngorms but worth checking up to date forecasts.
