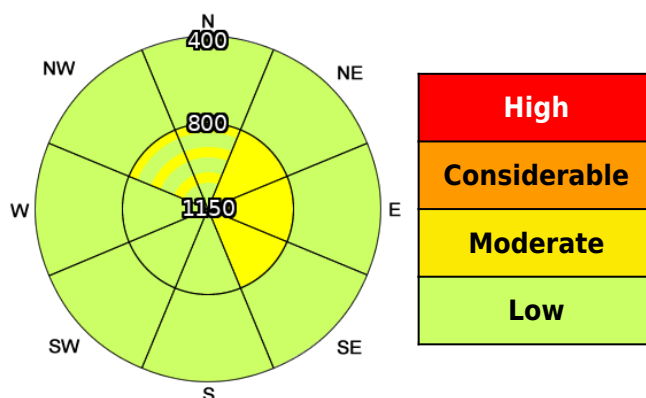


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 25/03/2015****Avalanche Problems****Wind Slab****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected in snowpack conditions. Areas of soft unstable windslab will remain on mainly North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Accumulations will form on other aspects due to wind re-distribution through the day, these deposits will generally be quite shallow with greatest depths being found around coire rims and the tops of gullies. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

After a few light snow showers during the night a dry day is expected. Light and variable winds will strengthen becoming South-Easterly through the day. The freezing level will be around 600 metres overnight, rising to 800 metres through the day.
