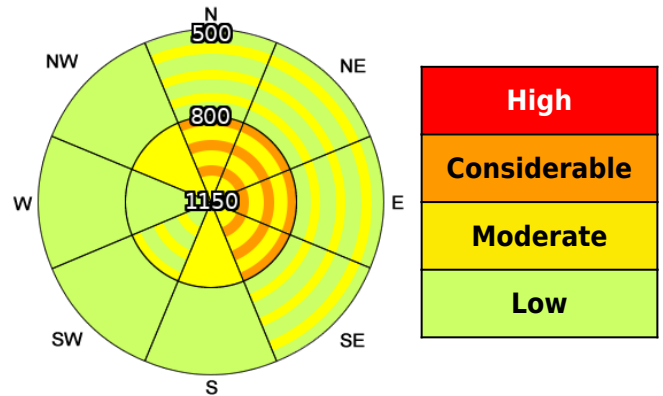
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will be deposited on North through East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Some windslab deposits will also be found on other aspects due to cross loading and variable wind direction. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

A band of snow will cross the area overnight, clearing to snow showers through the day. The freezing level will be about 600 metres. South-South-Easterly winds will veer to the North-West through the period.
