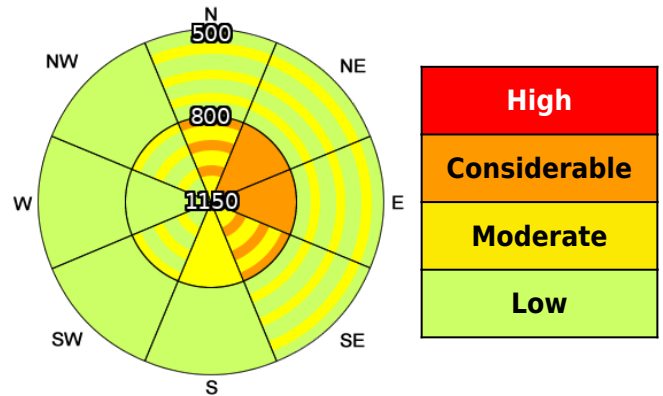

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will exist on mainly North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Below this level stability will be better. Fresh cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong North-Westerly winds will back South-Westerly and ease. After a generally dry night there will be snow showers through the day. The freezing level will rise from about 600 metres overnight to 800 metres through the day.

Comments

After a period of generally settled spring weather winter makes a re-appearance.
