

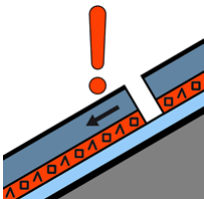

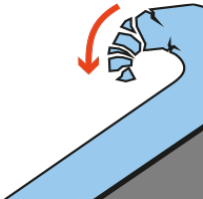

Wind Slab



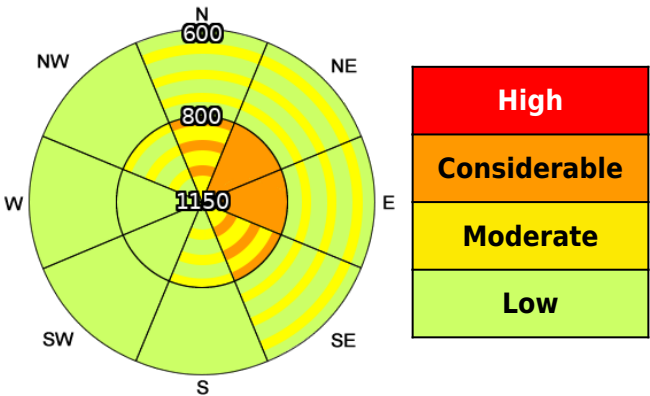
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing snowpack will start to stabilise as the temperature falls. Fresh unstable windslab will form, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres, with some cross loading of North-West and South facing slopes possible. Remaining cornices will build and be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

The wind will be mainly fresh, varying between a Westerly and South-Westerly direction. There will be snow showers throughout the period, heaviest during the day. The freezing level will be around 600 metres.

Comments

The period of thaw caused some avalanche activity, possibly due to cornice collapse. Prospect of colder showery conditions with fresh snow accumulations.
