

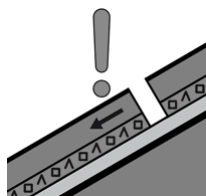

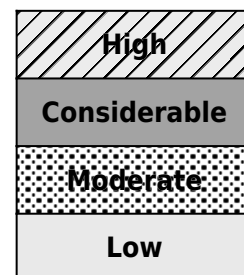
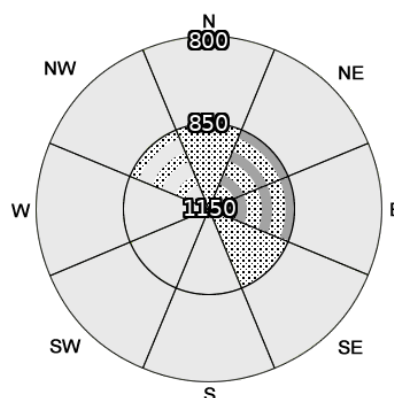
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The cooler temperatures will start to refreeze the snow cover at all levels, however a mix of older instabilities and new localised windslab will be present mostly on North-East to East aspects and some North and South-East aspects above 850 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

There will be light snowfall down to around 700 metres. Winds will mostly be from the West becoming very strong in the afternoon.
