

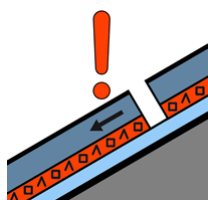

Wind Slab



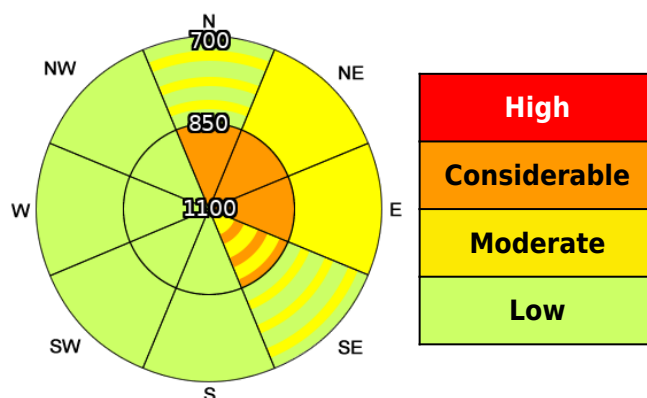

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The wet snowpack will refreeze and become stable in all locations above 800m. Stability will decline progressively during the day on North to East aspects above 850m. Period of poorest stability will be when snow showers and wind speeds increase from late morning onwards. Some new weak cornice development expected. Good stability on recently scoured aspects and exposed ridge lines. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Return to colder temperatures with West-South-West winds moderating overnight but increasing late morning. Snow showers throughout becoming heavier from morning onwards.
