

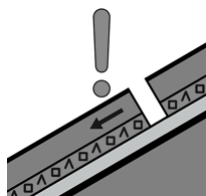

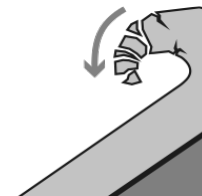

Wind Slab



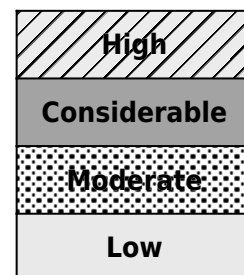
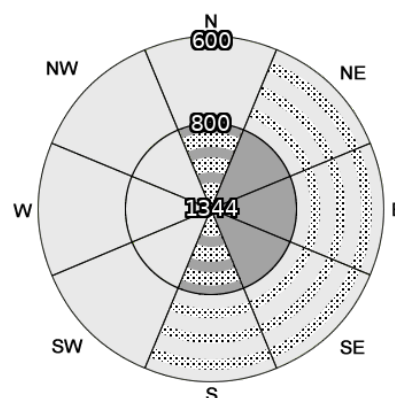
Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Large areas of unstable windslab will be present in areas sheltered from the recent Westerly winds. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North-East, East and South-East aspects above 800m. Localised accumulations will also be present on other aspects. Avalanches are likely in these locations. Cornices will be weak and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will decrease overnight and become light to moderate from a Southerly direction. The freezing level will be below 700m and there will be no significant precipitation.
