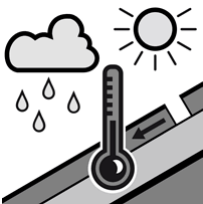


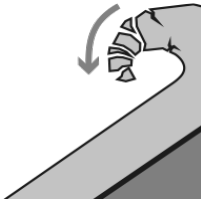

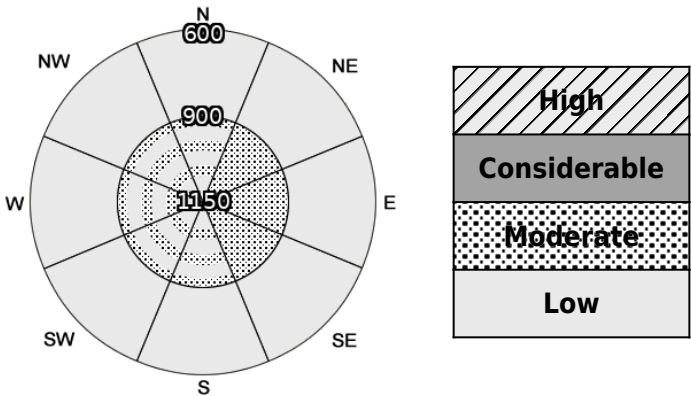
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Cooler conditions overnight will consolidate the snowpack then during the day the snowpack will soften and become moist. Some areas of unstable windslab will remain mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will be prone to collapse affecting slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, the freezing level will be around 950 metres, however, the air temperature will drop to lower levels. During the day the freezing will rise above 2000 metres and it should be mainly dry with fresh Westerly winds which will decrease during the day.

Comments

Generally dry for the next 48 hours.
