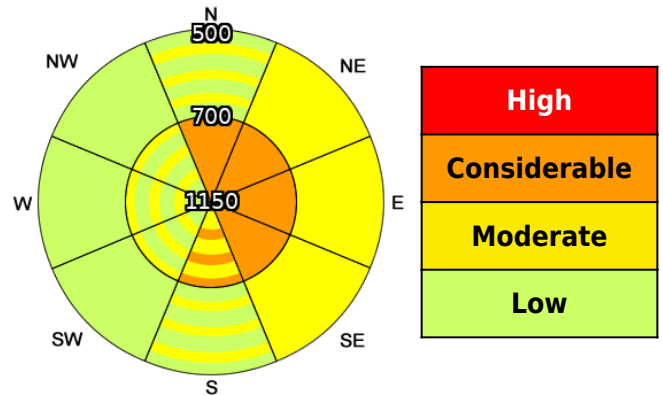

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to soften and steadily thaw at all levels. Above 900 metres instabilities will persist, mainly on steeper slopes with a North-East to South-East aspect. Other steep aspects also affected by localised wet snow instabilities. Cornices will be fragile and prone to collapse affecting slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It should remain generally dry with fresh Westerly winds. The freezing levels will be above the summits.

Comments

Mainly cloudy conditions but generally dry. Warm temperatures plus 5 degrees celsius expected on the summits, thaw conditions continue.
