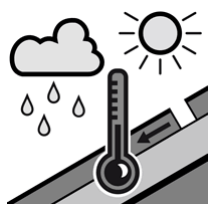


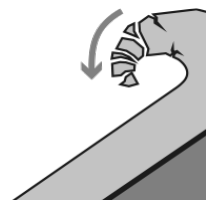

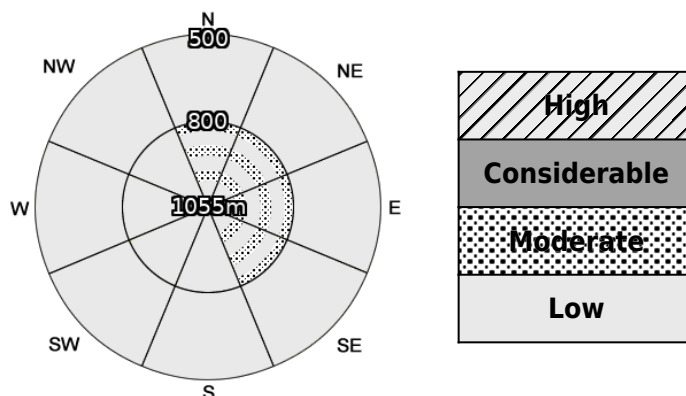

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly stabilise in most locations. Instabilities will be limited to steep convex terrain and the tops of gullies on North to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Risk of falling ice and cornice collapse will remain. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be light Westerly with a freezing level above the summits throughout the forecast period. There will be light drizzle overnight but the day will be dry.

Comments

A damp day with poor visibility. Significant snow remains at higher levels. Atmospheric and photogenic with the mist swirling round the ancient pines.
