

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw. Wet snow instabilities will persist, mainly on steep North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. The potential for full depth avalanches will affect a few specific locations on East and South-East aspects below this level. The large remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

A cloudier day with some very light rain and summit snow expected. Summit temperatures will be just above freezing. Strengthening winds will be from the South-West.

Comments

Rock and ice fall a hazard in the mild conditions.
