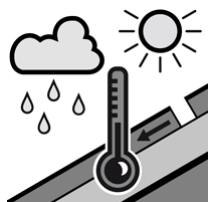
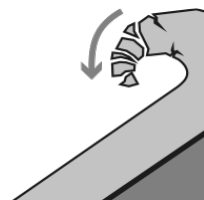
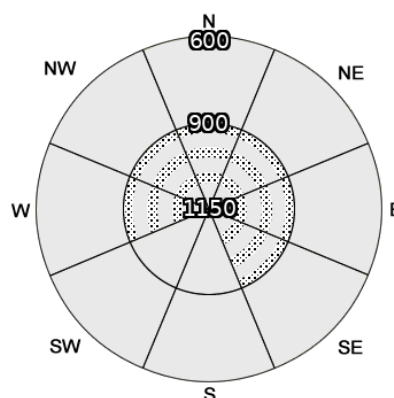


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 07/04/2015****Avalanche Problems****Wet Snow****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Little change is expected to the moist, soft snowpack, it will remain mostly stable. Some localised instabilities will persist mainly on North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 900 metres. Wet snow surface instabilities will also exist on steeper slopes with unstable cornices being prone to collapse, affecting slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

It will remain dry and mild with fresh Westerly winds. The freezing level will be above the summits.

Comments

Dry, settled conditions look likely to continue. As the thaw continues, there is an increasing hazard from cornice collapse and falling rocks both could affect the slopes below.
