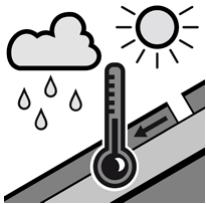


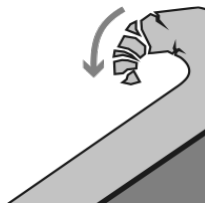

Avalanche Problems



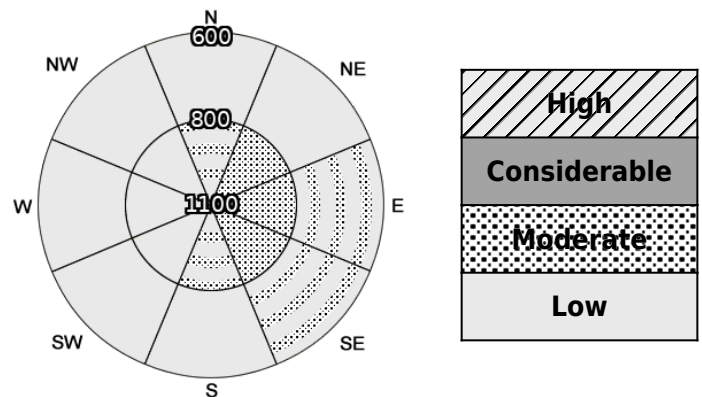
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change. Residual wet snow instability will persist on North-East to South-East aspects above 850m. Weak, large cornices above these locations will impose a high additional load in the event of collapse. Full depth glide cracks will continue to widen on selected East to South-East aspects at around 800m. Rock and ice fall additional considerations in the sustained thaw. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining dry and mild throughout. Moderate to strong Westerly winds.

Comments

Snow cover remains good on lee slopes but is diminishing in the sustained thaw. Late season hazards from collapsing cornices, widening glide cracks, residual wet snow instability and rock fall.
