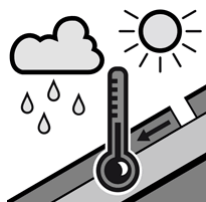
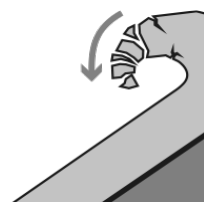
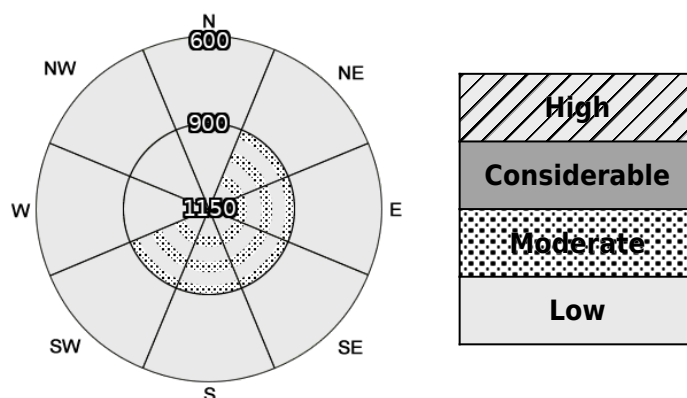


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 08/04/2015****Avalanche Problems****Wet Snow****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Localised areas of instability will persist mainly on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Solar warming will cause some wet snow instabilities on Southerly aspects. Remaining cornices will be liable to collapse and affect slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

The wind will be generally moderate from the West backing to a mainly Southerly direction. It will remain dry with periods of warm sunshine in the afternoon. The freezing level will be above the summits.

Comments

Rock and snow debris was observed in Coire nan Lochan from the Easter weekends thaw conditions. Further mild, dry weather in prospect this week.
