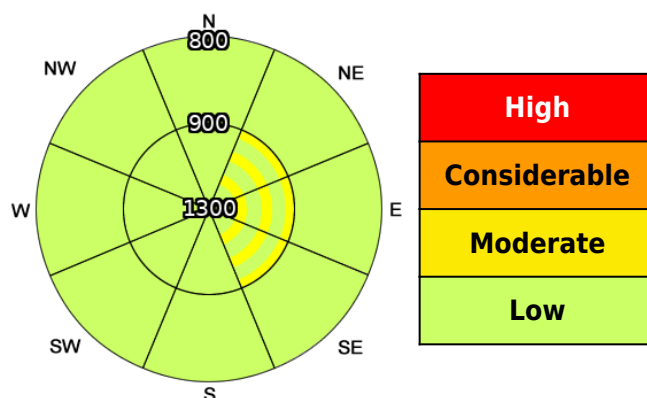
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw at all altitudes. Localised wet snow instabilities will affect steep and convex terrain on North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres especially on sun exposed slopes. Large cornices on many Easterly aspects will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry mild weather will continue with spells of sunshine through the day. Winds will be moderate to strong South-Westerly.

Comments

Firmer underfoot on shaded N aspects, evidence of rockfall below some of the buttresses.
