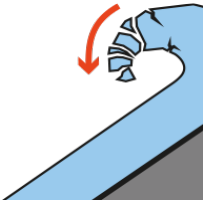

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 10/04/2015

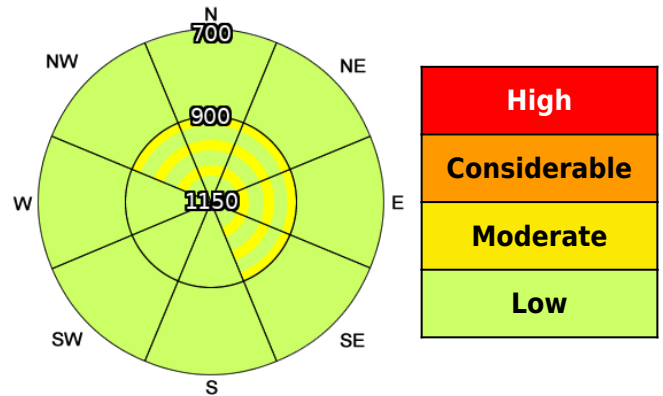
Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Overnight, the snowpack above 900 metres will consolidate as cooler conditions affect the area. It will soften again during the day leading to localised wet snow instabilities particularly on steep North-East to South-East aspects above 900 metres. Cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Cooler overnight then mild and dry again through the day with the freezing level above the summits. Strong Southerly winds.

Comments

Dry, warm conditions to continue. As the thaw continues, there is an increasing hazard from cornice collapse and falling rocks both could affect the slopes below. A return to more wintry conditions on Friday evening.
