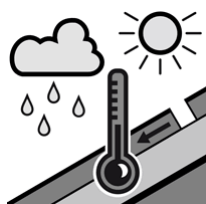


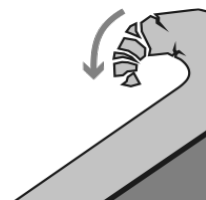

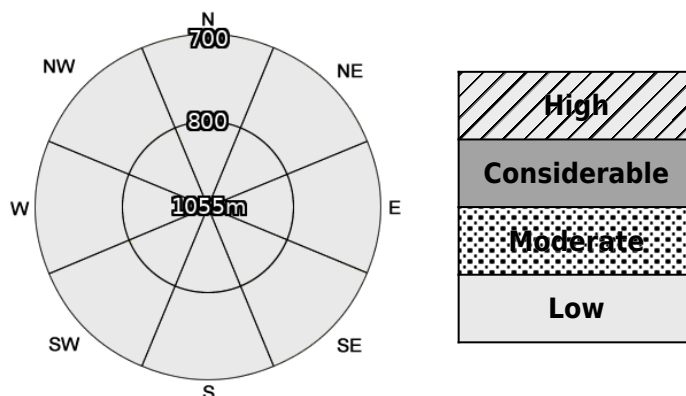

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected in the snowpack which continues to slowly thaw. Greatest amounts are on North-East to South-Easterly aspects above 800 metres. The snowpack although soft in the surface layers will generally be consolidated and stable throughout. Cornice collapse, rockfall, and wet surface slides on sun affected slopes will continue to present a hazard. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

A dry clear day is expected with strong South-South-Westerly winds and a freezing level above the summits.
