

Wind Slab





##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The surface layers of the old exposed snowpack will refreeze and become firmer in all locations. New weakly stabilised windslab will accumulate mainly on North East to South East aspects above 850m. Most affected areas will be gully exits and the top of steep coire backwalls. New soft cornice development expected above these places. Much better stability on all recently wind exposed locations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Wintry conditions return. Becoming cold with overnight snow showers extending into the day. Strong West South West winds.

##### Comments

Thermal shock! Becoming really wintry overnight. Daytime summits temps projected to be -4.5 degrees C. Freezing level around 600m. Remember to take your winter clothing and equipment if out in the mountains.
