

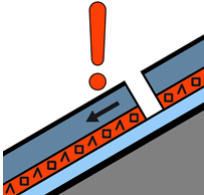

Avalanche Problems



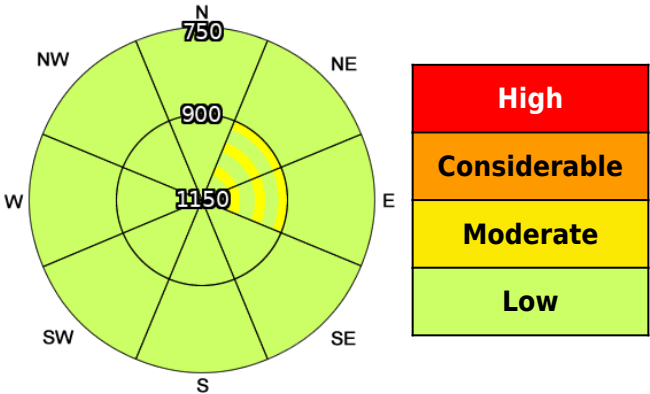
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Isolated new accumulations will start to develop mainly on North-East and Easterly aspects. On sheltered steep terrain above 850 metres where accumulations develop over older snow they will be moderately bonded. Elsewhere remaining older snow will refreeze with good stability. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

A return to cooler conditions. Occasional snow showers, down to around 600 metres, falling on strong South-West to Westerly winds.

Comments

A return to cooler conditions. Old snow will start to refreeze again.
