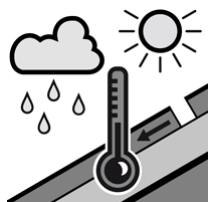


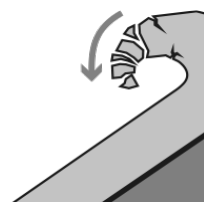

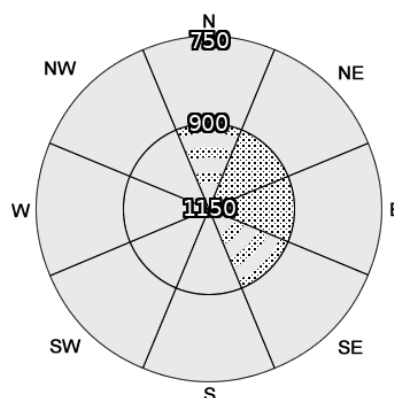
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Windslab accumulations will continue to consolidate; however some wet snow instabilities will develop in areas of steep and convex terrain on mainly North-East to East aspects above 900 metres. More localised instabilities will also affect North and South-East aspects. Remaining cornices will be unstable. Elsewhere the old snowpack will be well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain is expected at all levels overnight. Through the day mostly dry with occasional light rain. Strong South-Westerly winds will decrease to moderate. The freezing level will remain well above the summits.
