

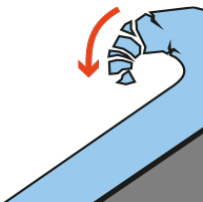

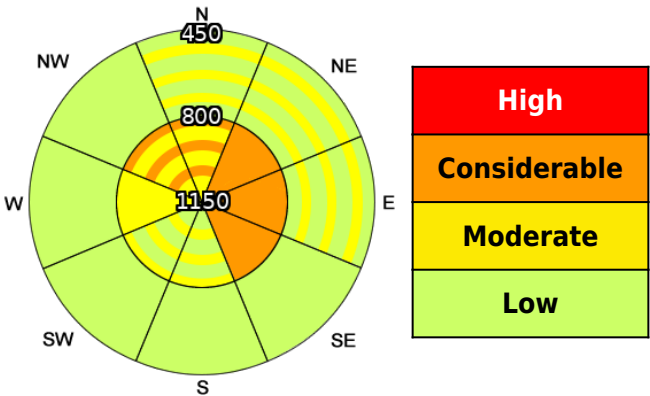
Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Rain will saturate the snowpack at all levels leading to wet snow instabilities on all aspects. Areas particularly affected are steep slopes and convexities on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres where avalanches are likely. Cornices will be unstable and prone to collapse, affecting slopes below. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will rise to above the summits, rain will fall at all levels leading to a thaw conditions. Winds will be gale force South-Westerly moderating during the day becoming West-South-West.

Comments

Weather conditions for Tuesday look very poor but improving during Wednesday.
