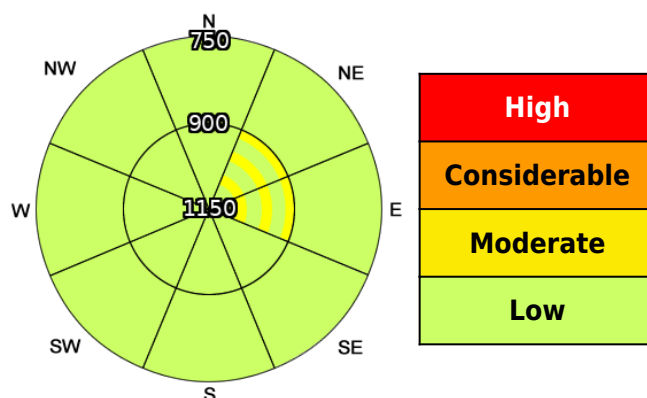


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 15/04/2015****Avalanche Problems****Wet Snow****Cornices****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The snowpack will continue to thaw at all altitudes but will be generally stable in most areas. Localised wet snow instabilities will persist in areas of steep terrain on North-East and East aspects above 900 metres. Any new snow amounts developing on East to South-East aspects will be very shallow and insignificant. Cornices will remain unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Rain at all levels overnight on moderate to strong West-South-Westerly winds. During the day cooler and drier with some very light snow above 700 metres on moderate West-North-Westerly winds, freezing level lowering to around summit levels.
