

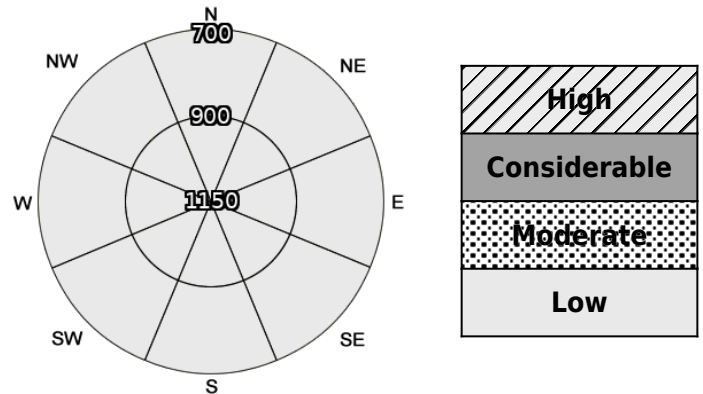

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 16/04/2015

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow amounts are not expected to be significant or to any depth, mainly a dusting above 800 metres. The snowpack will remain generally stable on all aspects and at all elevations. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, the freezing level will be around 700 metres, mainly dry with fresh West-South-Westerly winds. During the day isolated light snow showers above 800 metres the winds will slowly ease and the freezing level rising to 1100 metres.

Comments

Overnight the snowpack will freeze above 800 metres and be firm and icy.
